FAVORITE THING ABOUT BEING A LAWYER:

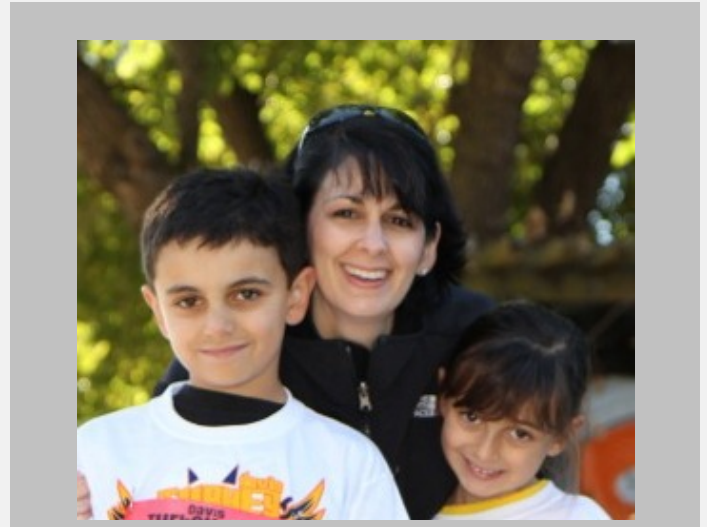
Lori likes that she meets fun people and learns new things every day. Each case brings a new set of facts, new people to meet, and is never the same.
